A PMHNP at TMC will:

- Demonstrate excellence in women's mental health care with interest or expertise in perinatal mood and anxiety disorders (PMADs).
- Provide outpatient care in both Day Hospital and Outpatient Department consisting of
 initial evaluations, consultations, psychotherapy and medication management for
 women with psychiatric disorders that are trying to conceive, struggling with fertility
 issues, experiencing grief and loss, in pregnancy or postpartum.
- Demonstrate expert clinical judgment, crisis assessment and intervention, and decision-making skills reflecting ability to manage patients with acute illness.
- Exercise strong clinical leadership skills and demonstrate effective clinical teaching skills
 used to promote both care and practice standards and will be adept at working with
 adult individuals and their families.

Responsibilities



In addition to the above, a PMHNP at TMC is expected to:

- Assist in efforts to ensure clinical standards are in place to meet regulatory requirements.
- Collaborate closely with multidisciplinary team to achieve treatment goals.
- Effectively monitor and evaluate patient outcomes.
- Manage records, correspondence and related items with utmost security and document according to regulatory standards.
- Complete all documentation and paperwork in a timely fashion and in accordance with TMC standards and policies.
- Perform other job-related duties as required by the Medical and Clinical Directors.
- Uphold the highest level of professionalism including attitude, timeliness, HIPAA compliance and confidentiality, treatment frame, boundaries, and adherence to TMC policies.
- Embody cultural standards of TMC including respect, kindness, collaboration, accountability, and collegiality.

Expectations

- Committed to working with and treating women experiencing PMADs.
- Works well with multidisciplinary team of professionals with whom to consult and collaborate about patient care and complex cases.
- Able to give and receive constructive feedback.
- Have and maintain your own malpractice insurance.
- Experience in perinatal psychiatric disorders, maternal-child health and issues of women's health care preferred but not mandatory.
